WEST MIFFLIN SANITARY SEWER MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY

**A RESOLUTION OF THE WEST MIFFLIN SANITARY SEWER MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 19-97, 41-99 AND 85-04 BY REVISING REQUIREMENTS FOR DYE TESTING.**

**WHEREAS**, the West Mifflin Sanitary Sewer Municipal Authority, on June 5, 1997, adopted a Resolution establishing requirements for evidence of compliance with the laws and regulations controlling the introduction of storm water and surface water into the Authority's sanitary sewer system prior to the sale of real estate within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, such evidence of compliance is required as a condition precedent to the issuance of Borough lien letters; and

**WHEREAS**, certain procedures were established for securing said evidence of compliance, including the requirement for dye testing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority desires to amend a certain section of Resolutions 19-97, concerning the requirements for dye testing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** as follows:

1. Section 3 of Resolution 19-97 is amended to include the following:


Further, if the Dye Test reveals the existence that: 1) the property's lateral line is not connected; 2) there is an improper/illegal connection to the sanitary system; or 3) downspouts located on the property are draining into the sanitary system; then no Evidence of Compliance will be issued until the improper/illegal connection is removed and/or the property is properly/legally connected to the sanitary system. All costs associated with the Dye Testing and all other work performed to be properly/legally connected to the sanitary system will be the sole responsibility of the property owner. The Authority will not be responsible for any costs associated with the Dye Testing or any other work performed under this Resolution.


2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon enactment and approval.
